

GRAMS Grants – Funding Proposal State - Quick Guide

Funding Proposal States

This chart contains descriptions for each GRAMS Funding Proposal state within the Grants module.

GRAMS State	Description
Draft	This is the initial state of the FP when created and will remain in draft while being worked on by the Principal Investigator (PI) and/or Proposal Team, including Proposal Managers.
Department Review	Proposal has been submitted to the PI's department and is waiting for department and college review and approval. Proposal will go to the Department Approver first (Step 1). Once the Department approves, the proposal will then go to the College Approver (Step 2).
Department Review: Response Pending from PI	Department or College reviewer has requested changes from the PI and/or Proposal Team.
Specialist Review	Proposal has been approved by the department and college and has now been routed to GCA for review.
Specialist Review: Pending Changes by PI	GCA has requested changes from the PI and/or Proposal Team.
Pending Submission to Sponsor	GCA has completed review of the proposal and proposal is ready to be submitted to the sponsor.
Pending Sponsor Review	Proposal has been submitted to the sponsor by either GCA or the PI as appropriate.
Post-Submission Update Requested	To be used when a JIT request is received from an NIH Grants Management Specialist (GMS), a C&P/Budget Revision/PFU is requested from NSF, Post-Submission Materials need to be submitted to NIH, or any other Post-Submission Update (PSU) needs to occur for a proposal. <i>Note: once submitted, the state will revert to Pending Sponsor Review.</i>
Pending Sponsor Review Award Anticipated	Proposal has been Selected or Recommend for Funding by the Sponsor. <i>Note: This is not an official award notice and sponsor may prohibit official communication until an official award notice is received.</i>
Award Notification Received	An official Award Notice has been received from the sponsor and Specialist will be working to get award processed through Research Contracting or directly to Post-Award for ProjID setup.
Awarded	Proposal has been fully set up and awarded in PeopleSoft/EIS. This action is completed by the Post-Award team, once the ProjID is formally setup.
Not Funded	The sponsor declined to fund the proposal.
Withdrawn from Sponsor	The proposal was submitted to the sponsor and the PI decided to withdraw it or encouraged to be withdrawn from the sponsor. This could also be related to a Pre-Proposal that is withdrawn in GRAMS and a new record initiated once encouraged to submit a full proposal.
Not Submitted	The proposal was started in GRAMS but was not submitted to the sponsor.
