

UNT Greenhouse Use Information

- 1. No plants are to be moved into any greenhouse space without prior request for and approval by the Greenhouse Manager.
- 2. All plants must be properly labeled according to the UNT Plant Labeling Requirements.
 - a. UNT Plant Labeling Requirements (on webpage tab).
- 3. Greenhouse bench space will be allotted and charged by the 3'x8' (24 sq ft) bench section.
- 4. Graduate and unfunded projects can be discussed with the Greenhouse Manager and AVPR for special exceptions.
- 5. All grant proposal budgets should include greenhouse space charges.
- 6. The Greenhouse/Growth Chamber Space Request form must be completed and emailed to the Greenhouse Manager, gail.shadle@unt.edu to use greenhouse or growth chamber space.
 - a. Space Request form (on webpage tab).
- 7. The Growth Chamber User Information form must be completed and displayed on the front of the growth chamber, as well as emailed to the Greenhouse Manager, gail.shadle@unt.edu.
 - a. Plant Tracking and ID-Growth Chamber form (on webpage tab).
- 8. Included in Greenhouse Space Charge:
 - a. Regular maintenance and repair of greenhouse systems and components
 - b. Lamp/bulb replacement
 - c. Provide soap, paper towels, first aid kit and spill kit in each greenhouse headhouse
 - d. Pest scouting & identification, purchase of pesticides, equipment and PPE, and application of pesticides by a licensed professional
 - e. Setup of benches and irrigation
- 9. Pesticide treatments for growth chambers and growth rooms will be charged a separate perapplication fee.
- 10. PIs will pay for bulb replacements in the growth chambers they are using.
- 11. The Greenhouse Manager will keep bulbs for the Percival growth chambers in stock for purchase.
- 12. The use of a greenhouse cell that is typically occupied by a specific lab in its entirety will be charged to the PI of that lab unless otherwise arranged with the Greenhouse Manager to share with other users.
- 13. User responsibilities regarding greenhouse use include:
 - a. Items used for plant care such as pots, soil, trays, fertilizer, plant labels, etc. must be purchased by the user.
 - b. Users are responsible for keeping greenhouse space and common space clean and free of dirt, debris, plant material and refuse.
 - c. Users are responsible for disposing of their plants properly. User will autoclave all materials requiring it.
 - d. Thorough cleaning of space used upon experiment completion is required.
